- All PLAYMOBIL® products have been tested for phthalates since August 2006. The phthalates level in our products is below 0.1%, and thus satisfies the CPSIA.
- Since 1990, all materials used by Playmobil have been tested for the migration of lead according to the European standard EN 71-3. The results have always been below 90 ppm, and thus below the CPSIA limit.
- All PLAYMOBIL® products now being exported to the U.S. are being tested for lead content pursuant to the CPSIA. The lead level in our products is below 90 ppm, and thus satisfies the CPSIA.

PLAYMOBIL® products are being tested by an independent, CPSC-accredited testing institute: LGA QualiTest GmbH, TÜV Rheinland Group, Tillystr. 2, D – 90431 Nürnberg.
